



## Jyväskylän Voimistelijat '79 (Jyväskylä, Finland) is looking for a high-level WAG head coach

Jyväskylän Voimistelijat '79 is home club of 1997 high bar world champion Jani Tanskanen and 1998 European silver medalist Jari Mönkkönen. The club has continued to produce high-level MAG gymnasts but so far has never been as strong on the WAG side. On 2013 the club started a project to raise the level of their WAG program. We have so far upgraded the facility to better meet the needs for WAG and we believe the gym is now among the best ones in Finland. We also managed to hire a coach to improve the girls' basics and physical abilities. We are now ready to take the next step and we are looking for a high-level head coach, preferably with good spotting skills, to teach the girls more advanced skills.

The primary responsibility of the coach we are looking for would be to coach the most promising girls of the club (approximately 12 girls, aged 8-13) and also to assist in the development of another 15-20 gymnasts (mainly on asymmetric bars). Another important task would be coach education within the club. We expect the coach to speak good English, of course preferably Finnish. Admittance: according to agreement, but as soon as possible.
