Full-time Head Coach for young talented and junior gymnasts in Women's Artistic Gymnastics

We are looking for a person with strong communication and soft skills. In addition to sporting and technical knowledge, the position of Head Coach for young talented and junior gymnasts also requires the ability to promote and coordinate relations with the regional performance centres as well as with the various specialized areas of coaching, medicine, science and school.

Tasks

- Ensure the sustainable development of Women's Artistic Gymnastics in Switzerland together with the Head Coach of the national squad and with the person in charge of training the athletes
- Ensure the guidance of young talented and junior gymnasts as well as of the team of coaches of young talented gymnasts
- Visit regularly the regional performance centres and bring a technical support to them
- Coordinate the education and implement the Head Coach technical directives within the regional performance centres as well as during the central education curriculum
- Promote the athletes' self-competence and personal development
- Put in place gatherings (for young talented and junior gymnasts) and make sure they run on well
- Prepare the gymnasts to major international events (JEC, EYOF, YOG) as well as to national and international competitions and international tournaments for junior gymnasts
- Plan the selections of squads and make sure they run on well
- Collaborate in the competition and education programs in Women's Artistic Gymnastics

Requirements

- A coach certificate at the highest level (Switzerland: SGF coach diploma 3 (DTLG), France: State brevet of sports instructor 2nd level, Germany: coach diploma from the Köln Academy or equivalent education)
- Several years of professional experience as a Women's Artistic Gymnastics coach with a track record of success in the education and promotion of development of young talented gymnasts
- Proficiency in a national language - ability to communicate in French and German (B1, resp. B2, level)
- Willingness to learn another national language (German, respectively French) expected
- Good knowledge of the national and international gymnastics scene
- Knowledge of the Swiss sports system an asset
- High social, technical and personal skills
- Talent for management, leadership and responsible and ethical behaviour
- Ability to work under pressure, persuasiveness and organisational skills
- Driving licence (cat. B vehicles)
