Full-time Women's Artistic Gymnastics Head Coach

We are looking for a person with strong communication and soft skills. In addition to sporting and technical knowledge, the position of Head Coach also requires the ability to promote and coordinate relations with the regional performance centres as well as with the various specialized areas of coaching, medicine, science and school.

Two national coaches will be subordinated to the Head Coach. Both vacant national coach positions will be advertised once the Head Coach has been selected.

Tasks

- Ensure the technical guidance of the Women's Artistic Gymnastics national squad and of the national team of coaches
- Ensure the sustainable development of Women's Artistic Gymnastics in Switzerland together with the head coach in charge of talented young gymnasts and with the person in charge of training the athletes
- Exchange regularly with the regional performance centres and bring a technical support to them
- Plan individual trainings and promote the athletes' technical development
- Promote the athletes' self-competence
- Be jointly responsible and coordinate the collaboration with the medical team and sports science
- Prepare the athletes to major international events as well as to national and international competitions and international tournaments
- Select the teams together with the Head of elite sport.

Requirements

- A coach certificate at the highest level (Switzerland: SGF coach diploma 3 (DTLG), France: State brevet of sports instructor 2nd level, Germany: coach diploma from the Köln Academy or equivalent education)
- Several years of professional experience as a Women's Artistic Gymnastics coach with a track record of success at a high international level
- Good, respectively very good, knowledge in German, French or English
- Knowledge of the Swiss sports system an asset
- High social, technical and personal skills
- Strong communication skills
- Talent for management, leadership and responsible and ethical behaviour
- Ability to work under pressure, persuasiveness and organisational skills
