Purpose of the Role

As a Men's Artistic Gymnastics Coach, you are, together with the team, responsible for the development, guidance, and support of athletes within their elite sports pathway, aiming to achieve the federation's top-level sports objectives. You strive for top performances at an international level, aligned with our vision of ethical and healthy sports. Together with the team, you build a sustainable and professional elite sports environment where talented gymnasts can fully develop, with attention to each athlete's individual needs.

Your Responsibilities

- You are responsible for the preparation, supervision, and evaluation of daily training sessions for elite gymnasts aged 16 and older.
- You collaborate with your fellow coaches to develop the annual, weekly, and daily training plans.
- You are part of the coaching team led by the head coach.
- You plan and evaluate the content of the training sessions.
- You coach your gymnasts during training camps and competitions.
- You evaluate gymnasts and organize individual follow-up meetings.
- You supervise and conduct testing for gymnasts who are part of the Men's Artistic Gymnastics elite structure.
- You work in a coaching team where you're expected to operate according to the coaching philosophy, learning pathways, and the Gymfed sports model. Strong collaboration and flexibility are key.
- You collaborate with the interdisciplinary team (doctor, physiotherapist, psychologist, nutrition coach) that supports the gymnasts in wellbeing, medical care, and performance.
- You attend weekly team meetings and other meetings related to the elite sports structure.
- You participate in training opportunities and are always open to further developing yourself within your role.



Ideal Profile

- You have proven experience that demonstrates strong technical and pedagogical coaching skills.
- You hold a coaching diploma and possess the technical competencies and knowledge of international standards required to achieve results.
- You have insight into periodization, physical training, and injury prevention.
- You apply a positive coaching style and can lead, motivate, and inspire (young) adult gymnasts to reach their goals.
- You can organize your training sessions efficiently and independently, you are detail-oriented in your preparations, open to feedback, take initiative, and can make adjustments when needed.
- You value trust among colleagues and consider involvement with all partners important (gymnasts, coaches, medical staff, elite sports school, parents, etc.).
- You communicate transparently and constructively with all parties involved.
- You take responsibility for your tasks and strive to achieve the set goals within/with the team.
- You are dynamic, stress-resistant, and able to stay calm in challenging situations.
- You have the ambition, drive, and flexibility expected from an elite sports coach. Evening and weekend work is not an issue for you.
- You are fluent in Dutch or willing to learn it in the short term. You have a good command of English.
- You have a good working knowledge of Word, Excel, PowerPoint and Outlook.
- You hold a category B driver's license.
